

Notice is hereby given that a Public Meeting was held on February 23, 2026, at the Garrison City Hall. Members present were Mayor Keith Yarbrough, Arnie Kelley, Hope Hallmark, Tim Wright, Darrell Lunsford, and Travis Simon. Others present were Myke Chandler, Herbert Hancock, and Jenny Frederick.

Mayor Keith Yarbrough called the meeting to order at 5:01 P.M.

Darrell Lunsford led in prayer.

Council discussed bids for limb and debris pickup within the city limits. Drewery and Caleb Blankenship submitted bids. A council member will stay with the crew the entire cleanup time. Drewery bid \$496 per hour with one loader truck, driver/operator, and one laborer. Caleb Blankenship bid a 3-man crew at \$350 per hour with an 8-hour minimum. Discussion ensued. Tim Wright moved to accept Caleb Blankenship's bid to pick up debris and dump it at Travis Simon's land for \$350 per hour for 3 days or less. Tim Wright will monitor the work. Hope Hallmark seconded. All voted yea. Jenny will send a letter to all citizens within the city limits to inform them of the cleanup on March 16, 2026.


Council adjourned to closed session at 5:56 P.M. to discuss personnel per Texas Government Code 551.074.
