

Notice is hereby given that a Public Meeting was held on June 8, 2026, at the Garrison City Hall. Members present were Mayor Tim Wright, Hope Hallmark, Darrell Lunsford, and Travis Simon. Arnie Kelley was absent. Others present were Myke Chandler and Jenny Frederick.

Mayor Tim Wright called the meeting to order at 5:03 P.M.

Darrell Lunsford led in prayer.

There were no public comments.

Jenny Frederick presented the minutes from May 11, 2026, for approval. Travis Simon moved to approve the minutes as written. Hope Hallmark seconded. All voted yea.

Myke Chandler presented the Municipal Court report. The court collected a total of \$ 667.57. The city will keep \$ 493.57, and \$174.00 will be remitted to the state.

There were no contractor reports.

Jenny Frederick presented a presentation of the TDA Form A1024 CDBG Section 3 Program Goals Presentation for the TxCDBG Project CDV23-0099. There were no questions regarding the presentation.

Council discussed the alleyway plat at M&D. The alleyway was showing incorrect on the plat. The plat needs to be updated before being approved.

Council discussed an Application Filing and Authorized Representative Resolution for the Texas Water Development Board Water Supply and Infrastructure Grant Program. Council discussed Magnolia Street improvements. The road near the U S Post Office needs repaired; however, there is an area that needs pipe burst on the sewer line. Discussion ensued. Item tabled.

Jenny Frederick presented a reimbursement from the TXHB conference. The TXHB is reimbursing cities for their expenses to the conference for room and conference fee. Darrell Lunsford moved to approve the reimbursement. Travis Simon seconded. All voted yea.

Council discussed the 2 military trucks and generator sitting on the maintenance yard. Discussion ensued. Council wants to take bids on the 2 military trucks and donate the generator the GVFD. Hope Hallmark moved to submit a notice for taking bids on the 2 military trucks for 2 weeks. Darrell Lunsford seconded. All voted yea.

Council discussed bids for road work on Willow Street (Linn Flat) and W Cedar Street. Christian Excavation bid \$1615.75 to replace the culvert at W. Cedar Street, and \$2297 to fix the culvert on Linn Flat, \$1087.69 if dirt is unstable under culvert, and \$500 to dig the trench out. Randy McClain bid \$7000 to fix Linn Flat, and Dupree bid \$3600 to fix W Cedar Street. Discussion ensued. There will be no action taken on the Linn Flat culvert repair. Hope Hallmark moved to accept Christian Excavation to fix W. Cedar Street pending the bid includes ditch cleanout and utility coverup for \$1615.75. Darrell Lunsford seconded. All voted yea.

Council adjourned to closed session at 5:50 P.M. to discuss city personnel per Texas Government Code 551.074.

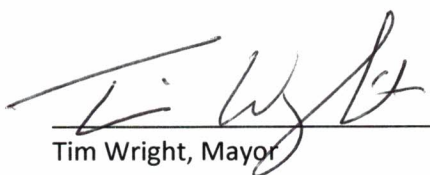
Council reconvened from closed session to open session at 6:15 P.M.

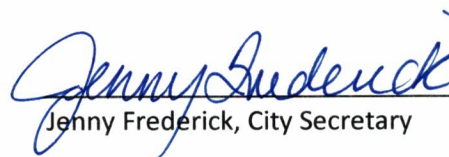
No action was taken.

David Godwin will be here on July 13th for the city audit. Multiple water leaks were fixed, and the RRC Audit will be here on the week of July 6, 2026. The council was informed of the new food truck laws that go into effect July 1, 2026.
