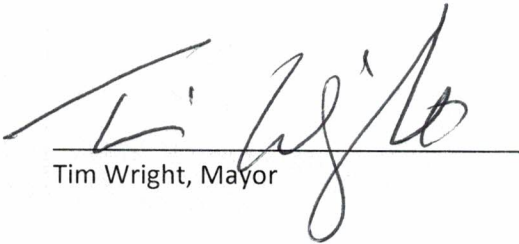
Mayor Tim Wright called the meeting to order at 5:10 P.M.

Darrell Lunsford led in prayer.

Matt Barrett discussed quotes to replace the water tank on Hwy 59 at Well 1. Matt contacted 17 companies and 3 responded. Superior Tank Company was the most reasonable for a galvanized 40,000-gallon tank for \$92,500. The same tank in steel will cost approximately \$41,000 more. Pittsburgh Tanks cost \$270,000 and are a year and half out. Bulldog Tank bid a steel tank for \$131,000. Steel tanks last forever but have to be remilled. Galvanized tanks will last approximately 40 years. Discussion ensued. Arnie Kelley moved to go for bid proposals for galvanized and steel tanks to replace the ground storage tank at Plant 1 on Hwy 59 that will be due September 14, 2026, at 5 P.M. Matt Barrett has authority contact the companies to solicit bids. Hope Hallmark seconded. All voted yea.

Council discussed the proposed 2026 tax rates. Hope Hallmark moved to go with the proposed rollback rates of 0.30275 per \$100. Darrell Lunsford seconded. All voted yea. The council will hold a public hearing regarding the proposed tax rates on September 14, 2026, at 5 P.M.

Hope Hallmark made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Arnie Kelley seconded. All voted yea.
